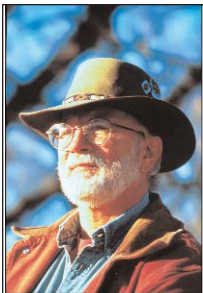
Claudia Schmidt Sat
