The Eve has a gothic body shape with a pointed tip to the pinblock and has generally a very bright sound. The Eve spacing is close. The Brittany harp has a traditional Irish body shape, slightly more tension, and a mellower sound. The string spacing on the Brittany is slightly wider. The Walnut Brittany can be strung with wire strings with a rich bell like sound quality. Both the harps have a retail cost of \$659.00 without levers. A set of sharpening levers, installed is \$325.00. Two brands of padded case w/base bag suitable for either harp is available for \$116 or \$105.00
