Both harps have the same exterior body design and bracing. The Braunwen is strung with 697 pounds of pressure: the Briar Rose with 714 pounds of pressure on the harp. The Briar Rose has slightly more string tension.

Both have a base retail cost of \$1399.00 without levers. A set of sharpening levers, installed is \$410. Two brands of padded case w/ base bag suitable for either harp available at \$205 or \$198.75.

The Briar Rose will be our 20th Anniversary Harp. We will be offering a complimentary, custom soundboard design of briars with rose buds during the year 2004 at no additional cost.
